To map partners' views on:

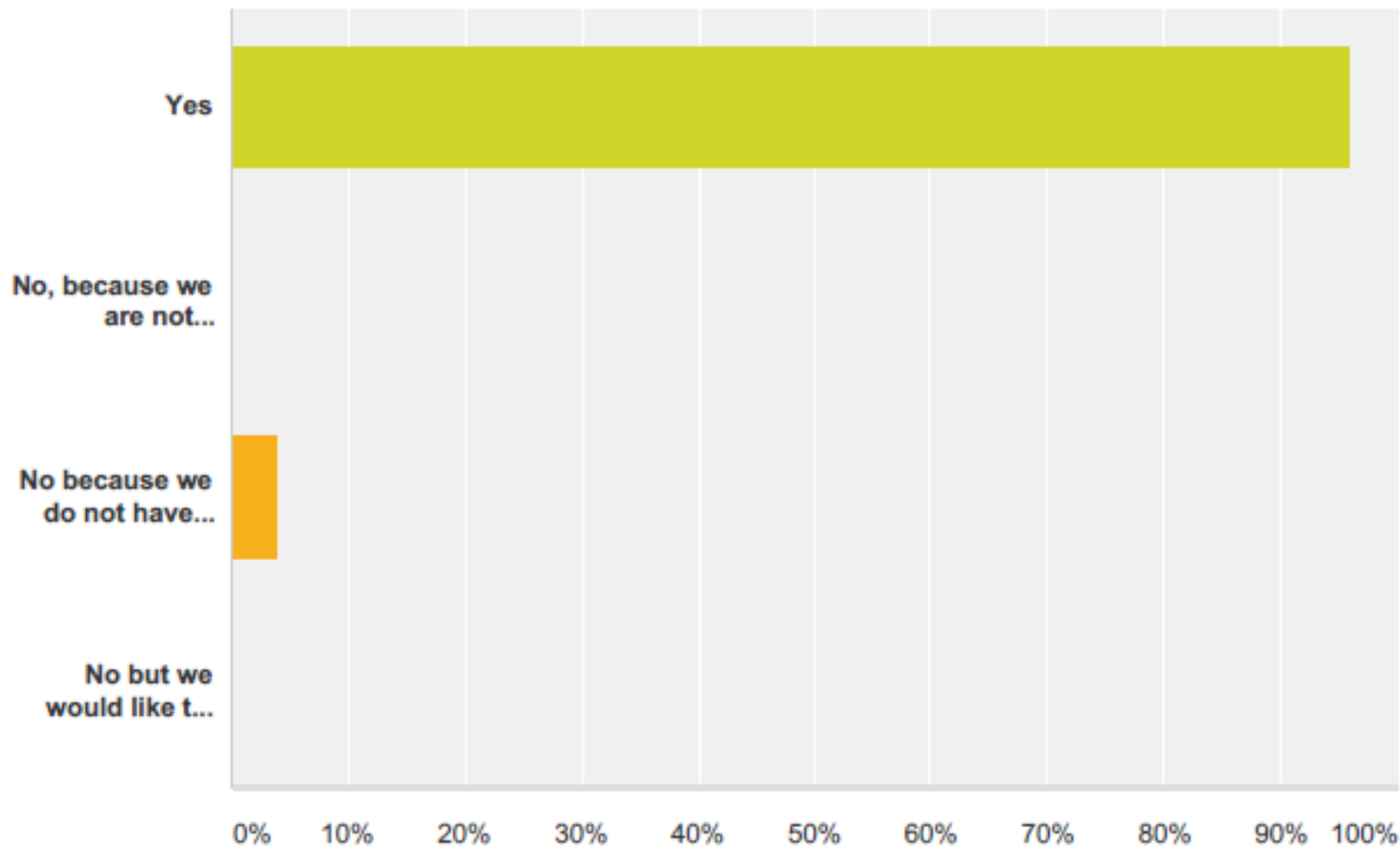
1. Do partners feel they are currently active members of gFSC

1. Do partners feel they are currently active members of gFSC?

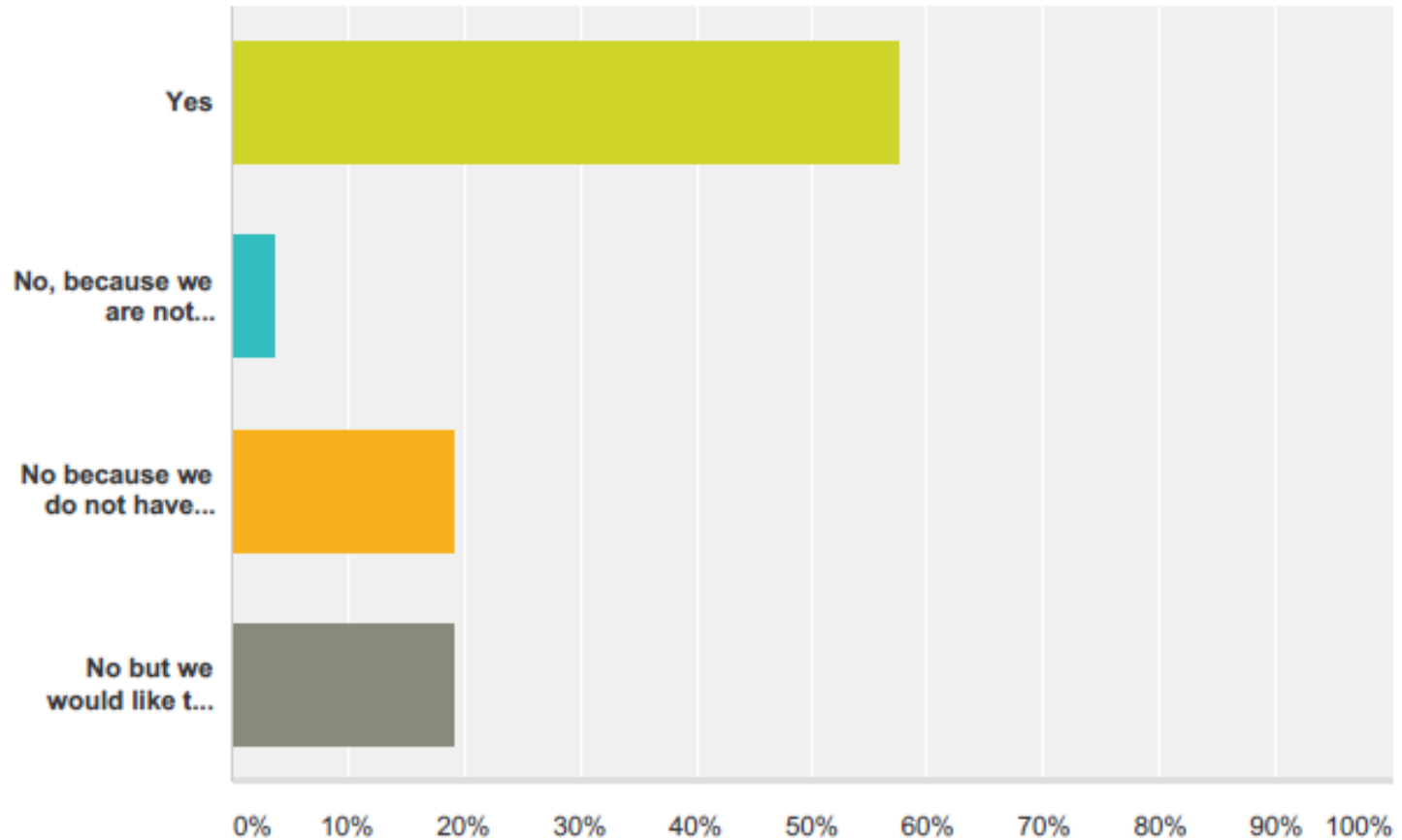
Q2 Is your organization an active member of the gFSC?

Answered: 25 Skipped: 3



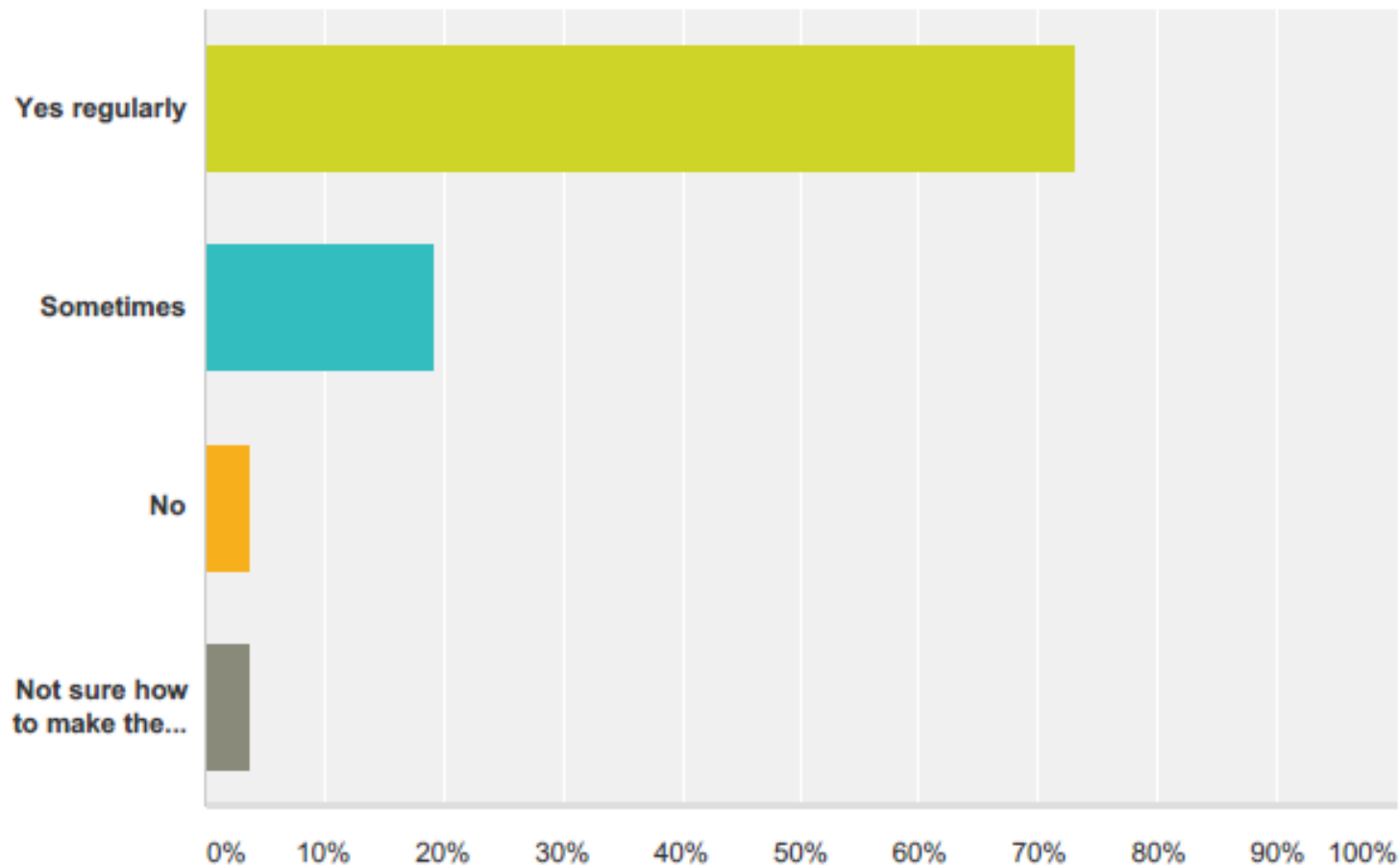
Q3 2. Does your organization have a leadership role in the gFSC (i.e. Working Groups, activities, strategic plan development, etc.)?

Q5 Does your organization at headquarters level encourage your country-level colleagues to participate in the country-level Food Security Clusters?

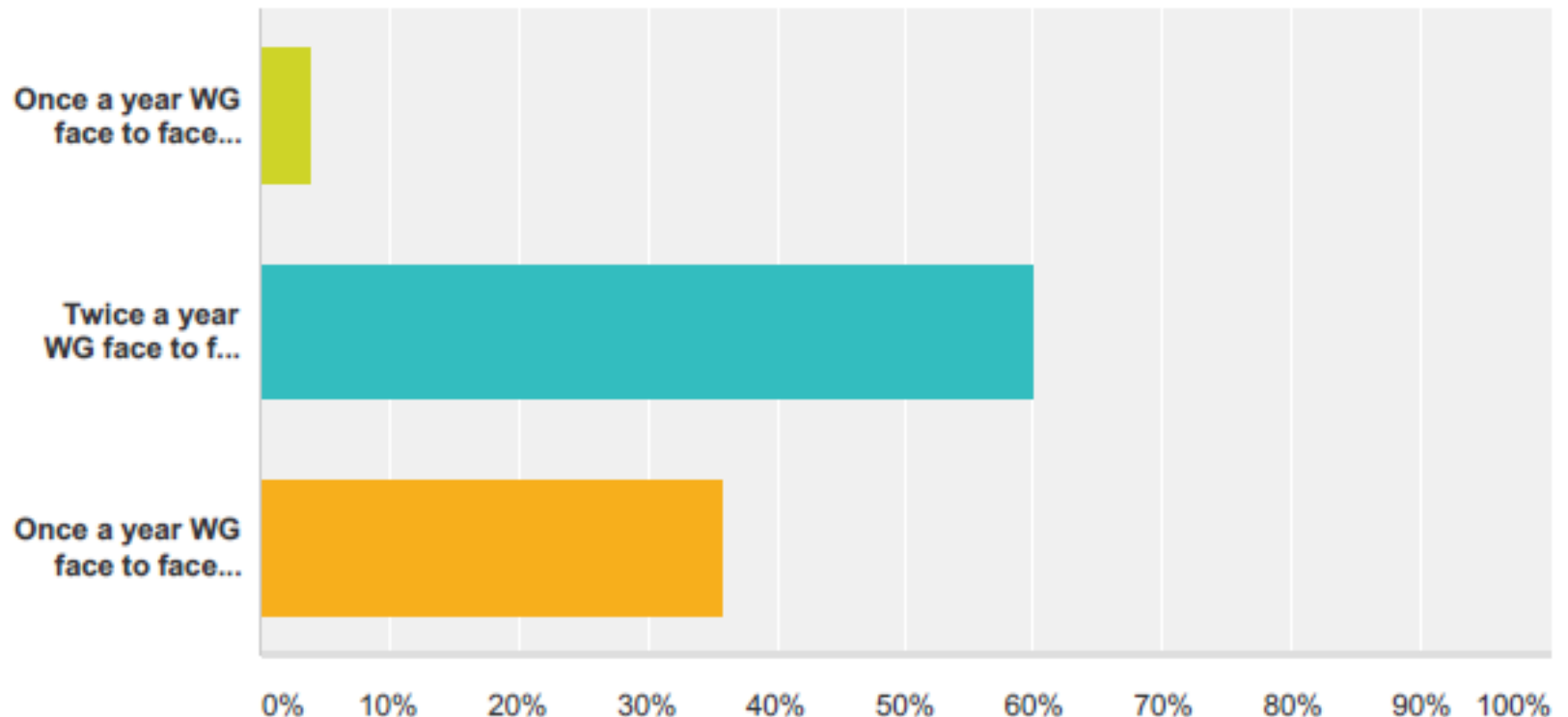

Q7 On which frequency would you like the Working Groups' face-to-face meetings to be followed by the gFSC partners' meeting?

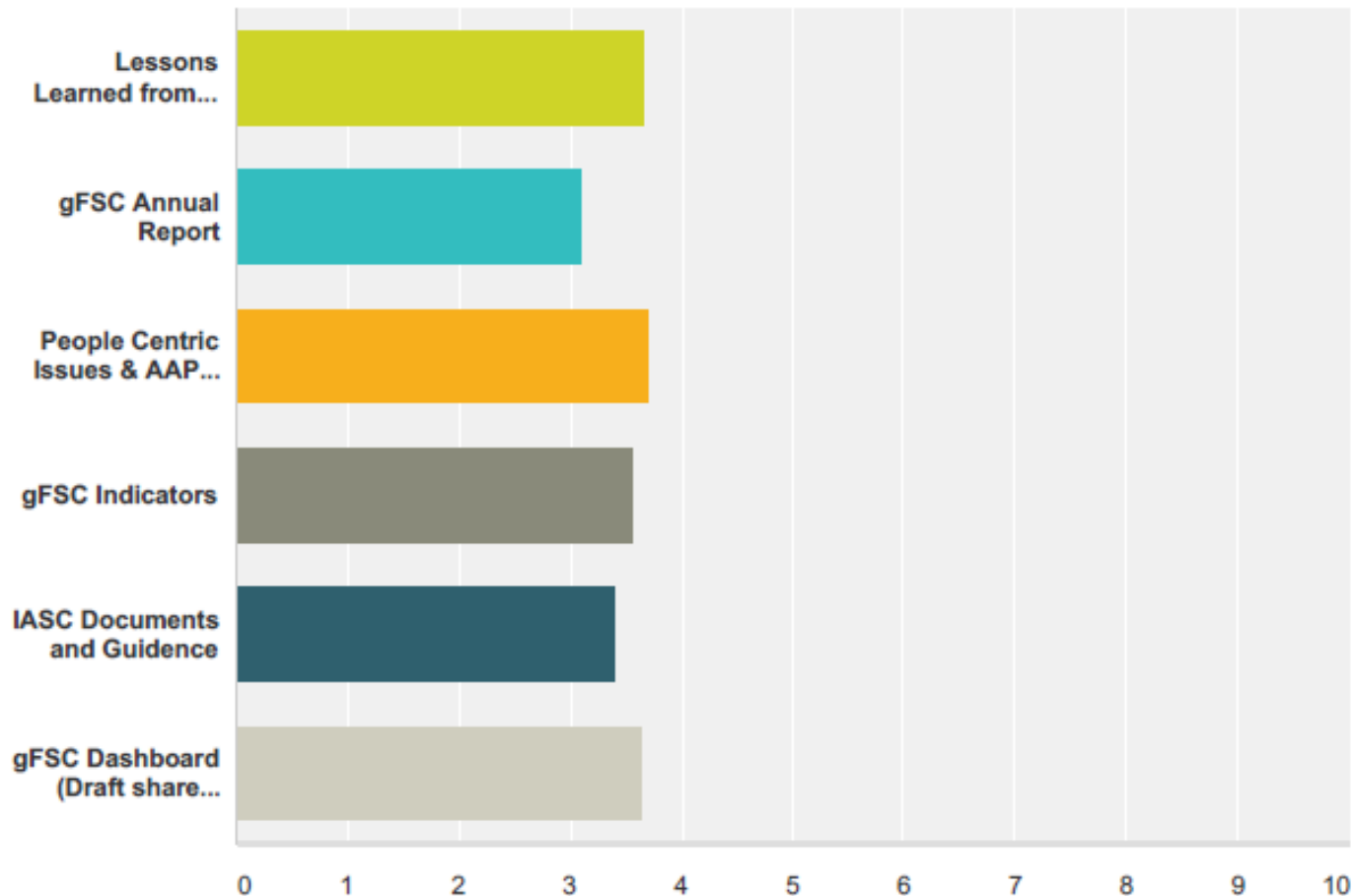

Q9 Which of the following gFSC products do you believe are useful in informing your organization on gFSC related work, and/or would like to see them improved and further developed?

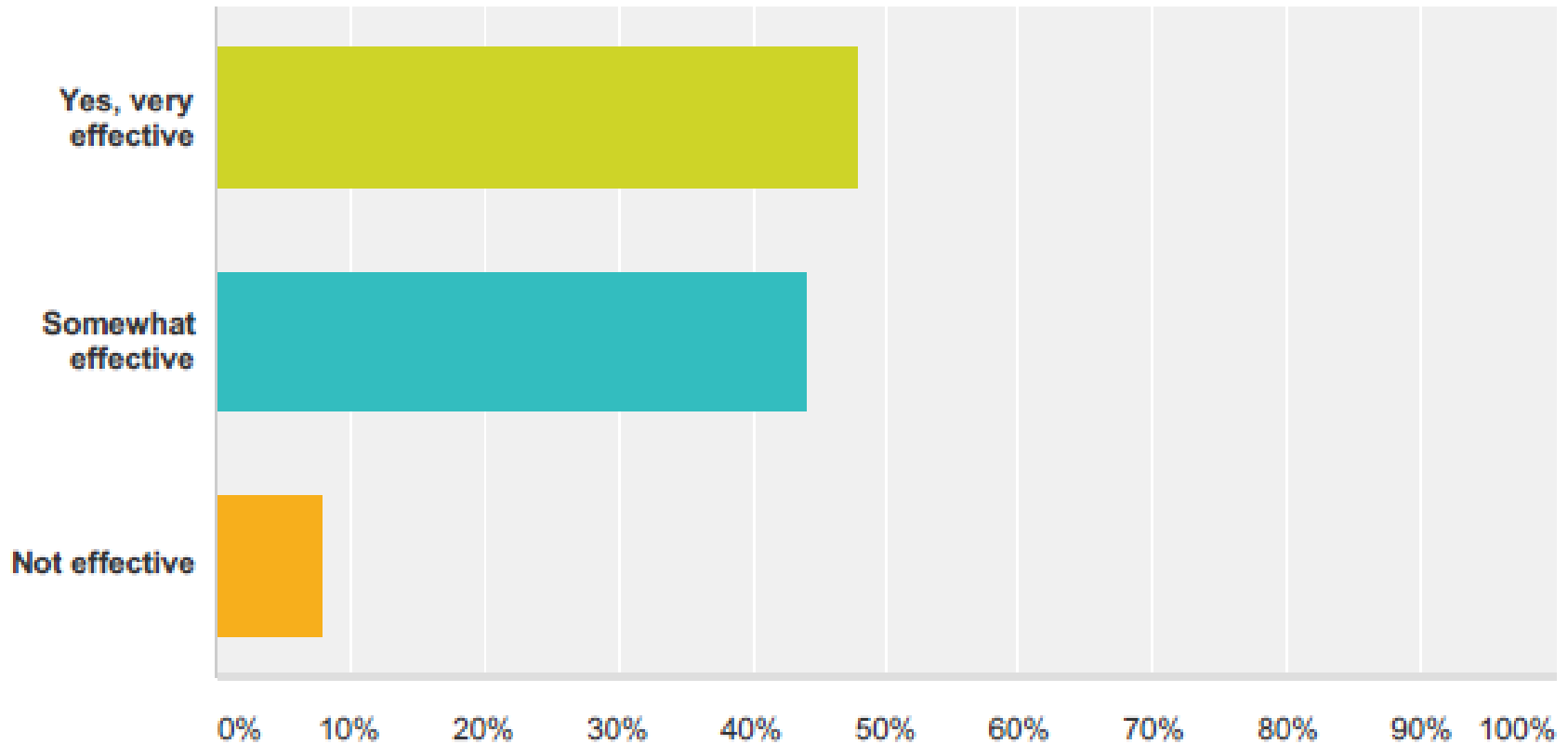

4. gFSC Governance

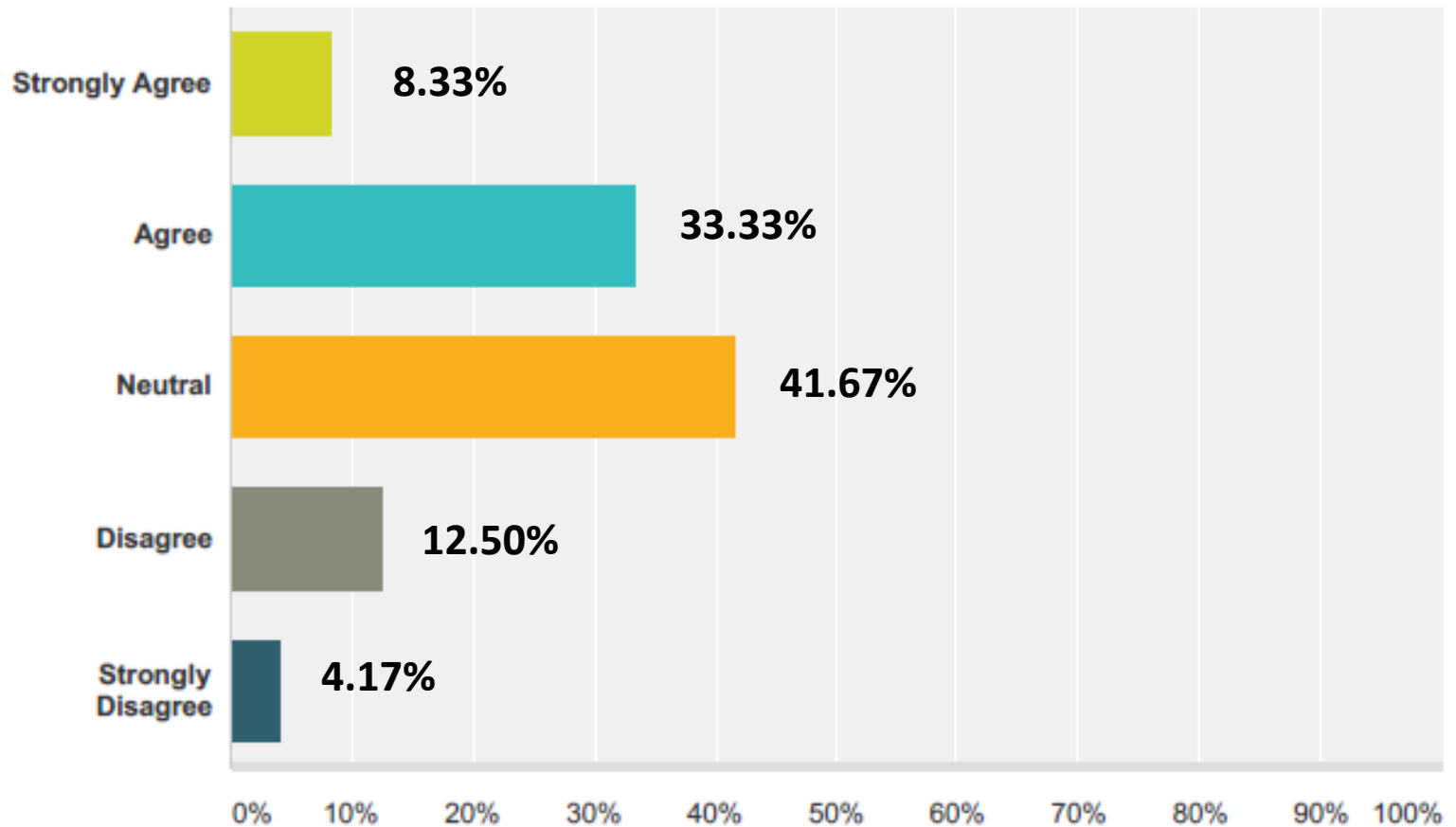
Q11 Do you feel that the gFSC has been so far effective in including partners' views in its strategic decisions?

Answered: 25 Skipped: 3



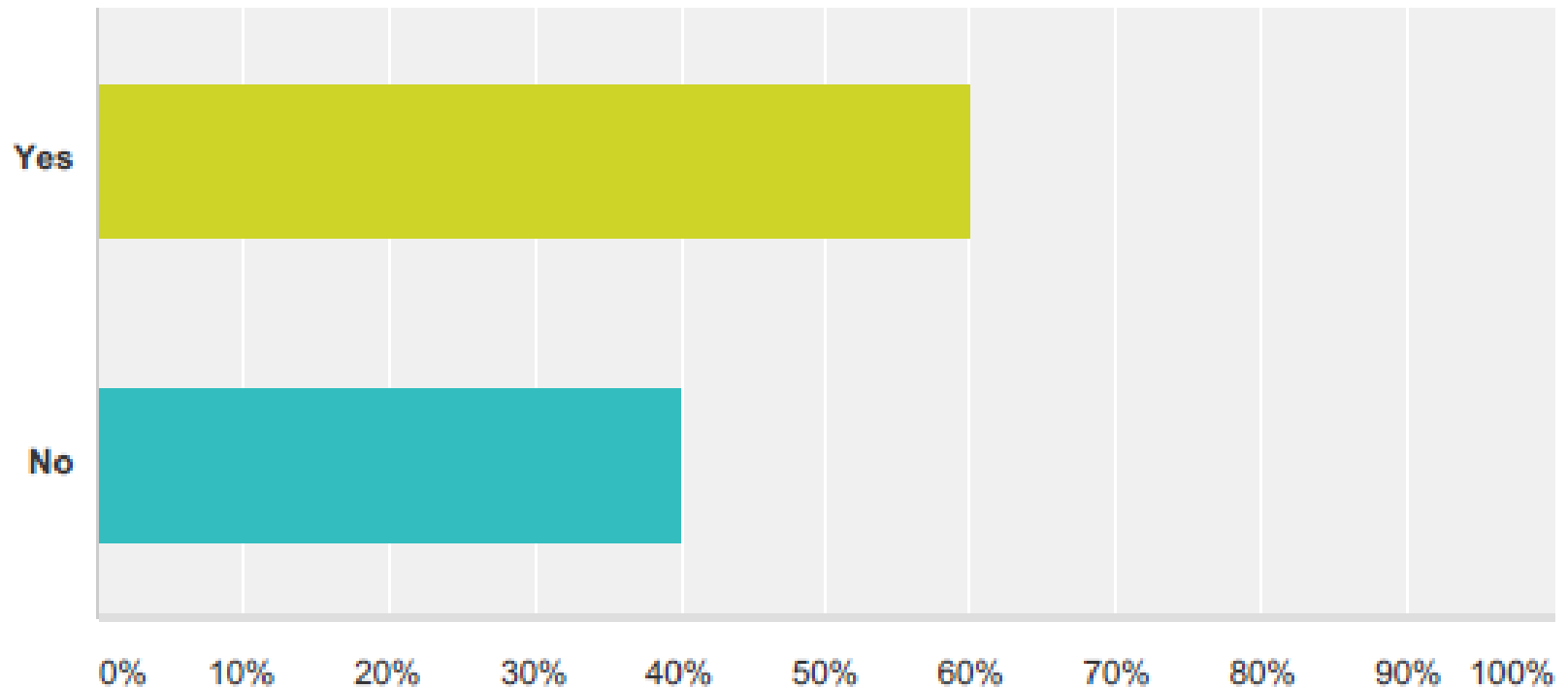
Q13 The gFSC current governance structure is appropriate to respond to current partners' needs.

Answered: 24 Skipped: 4



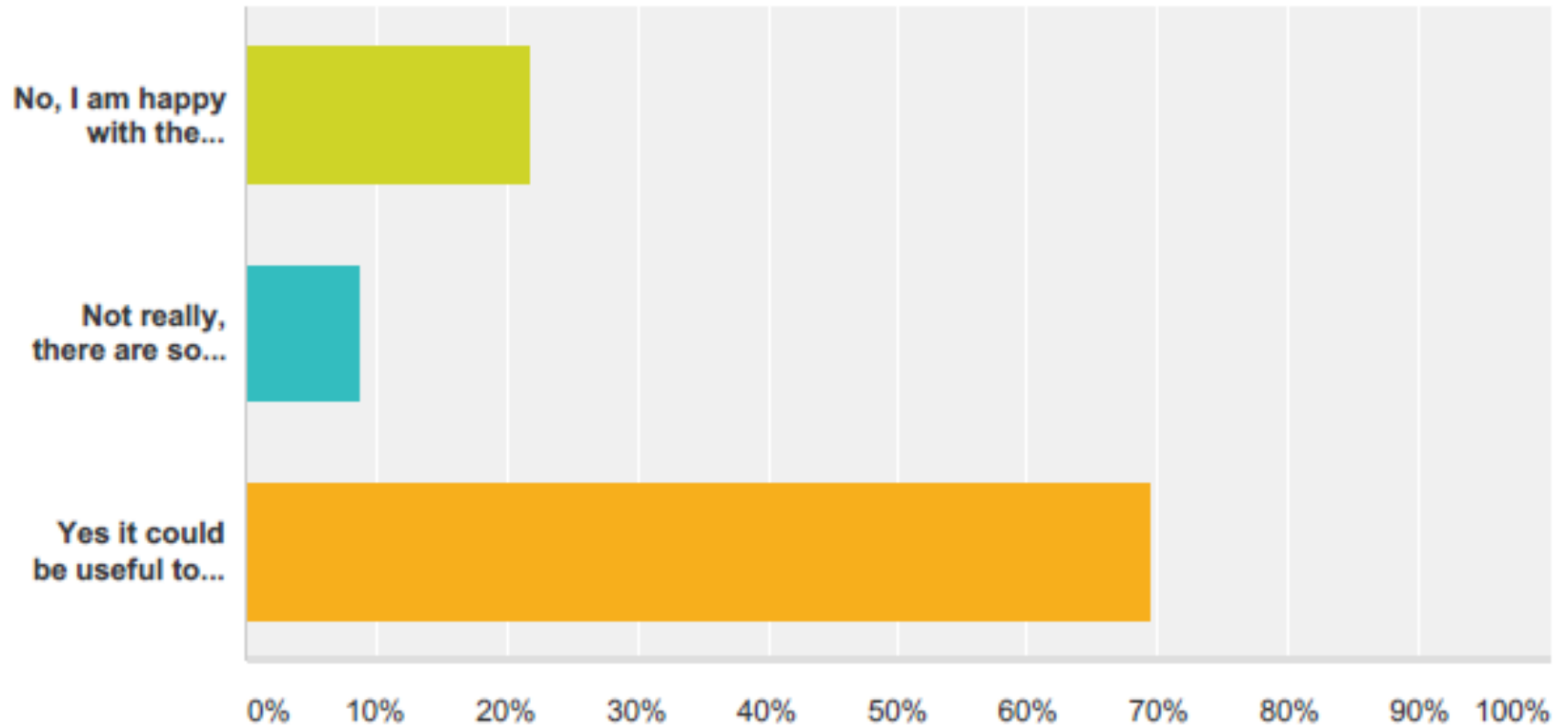

Answered: 25 Skipped: 3



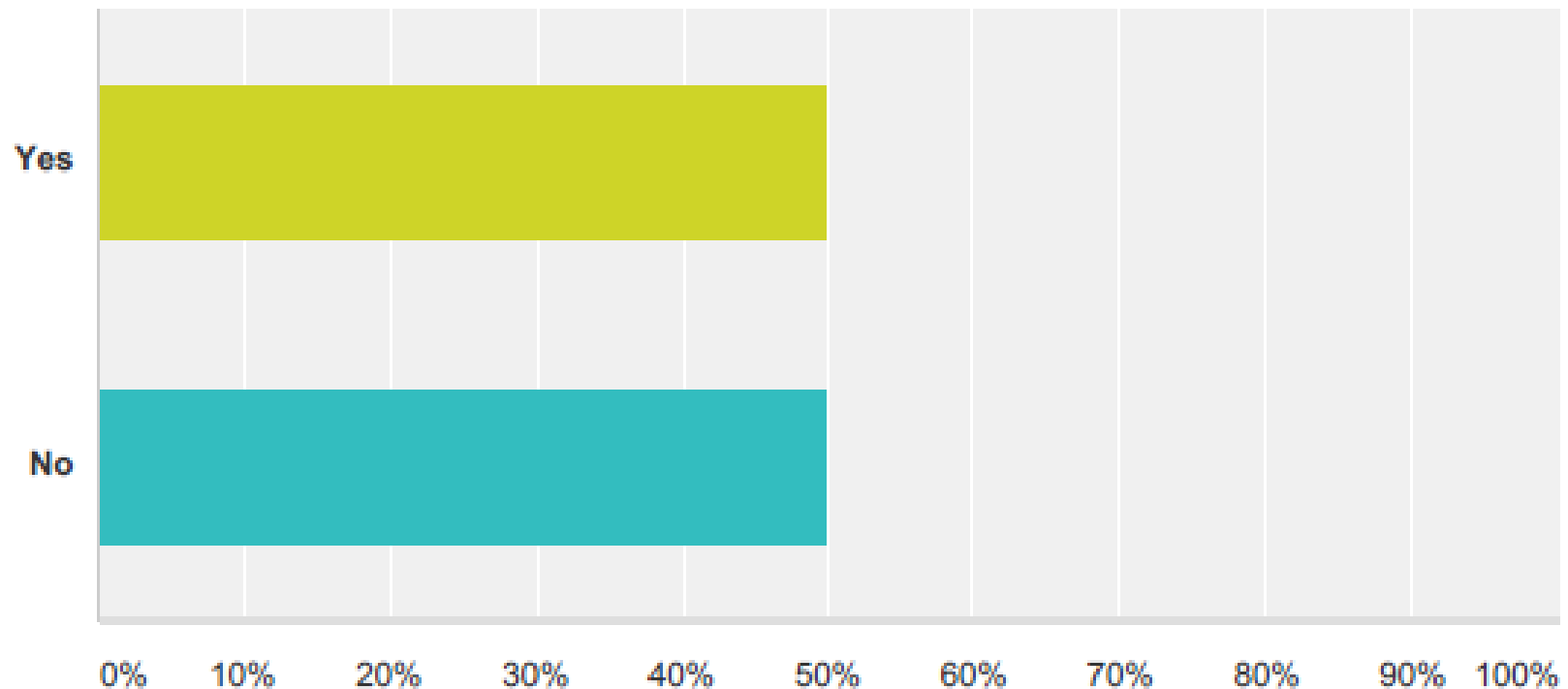
Q15 Do you think that a Strategic Advisory Group would add some value to the way you engage with the gFSC?
