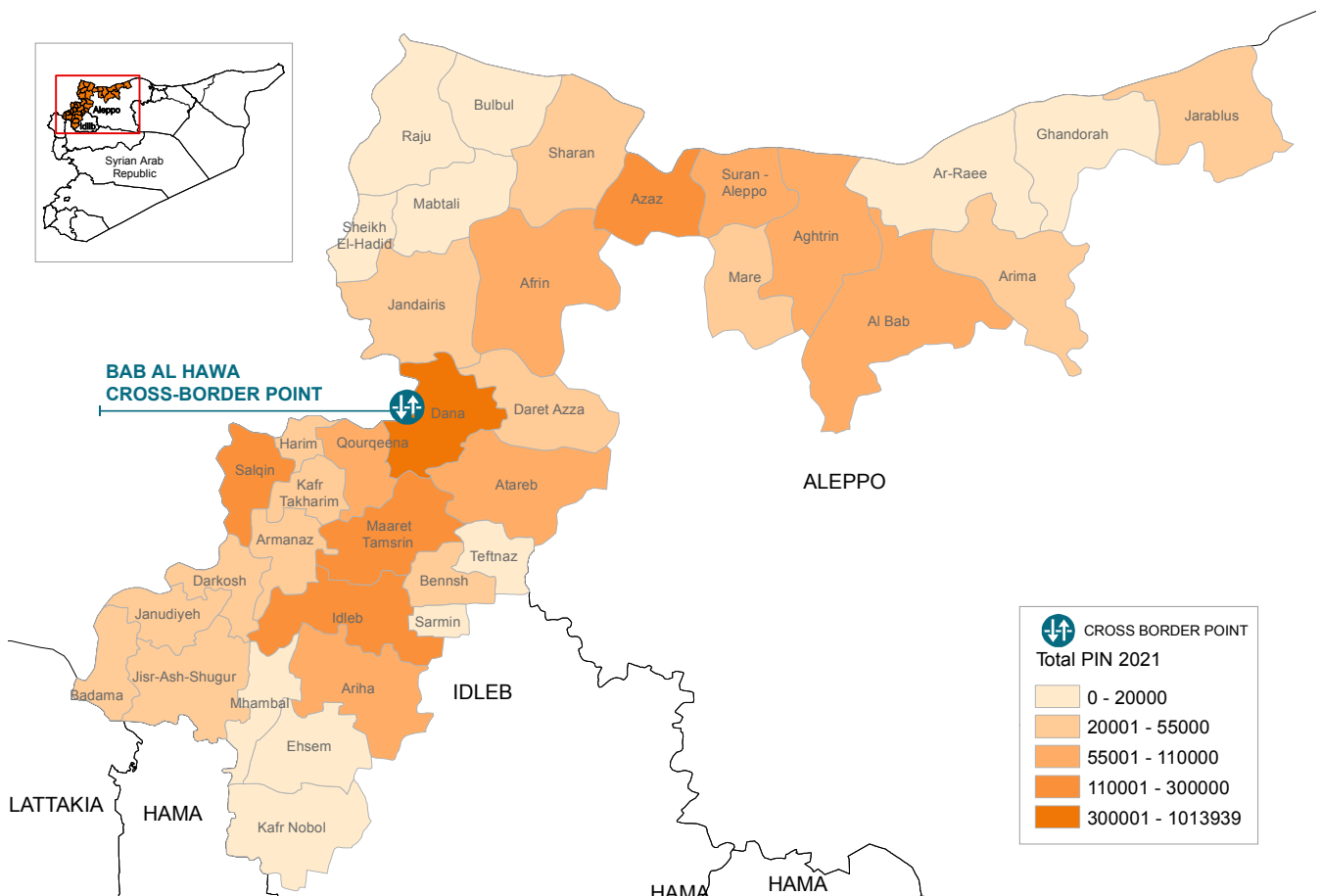

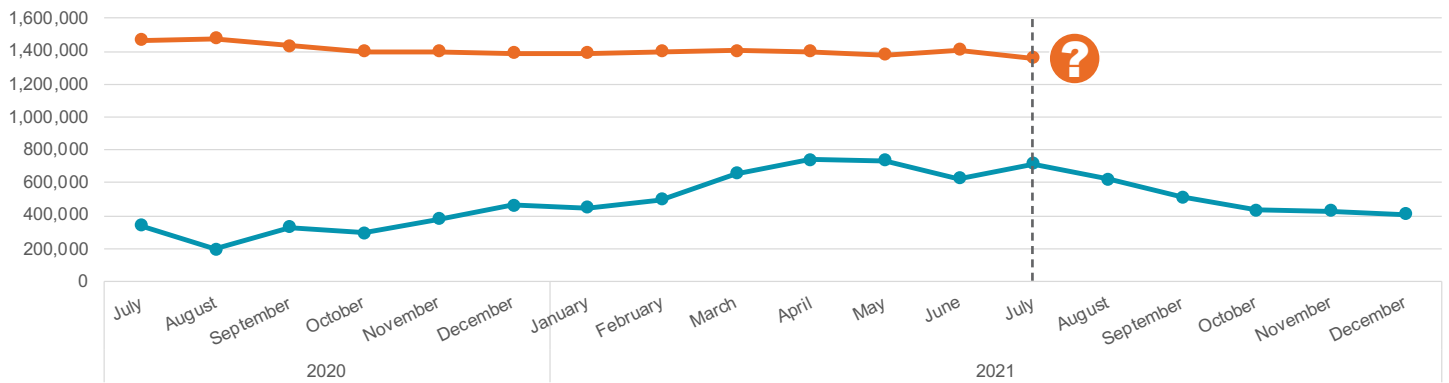

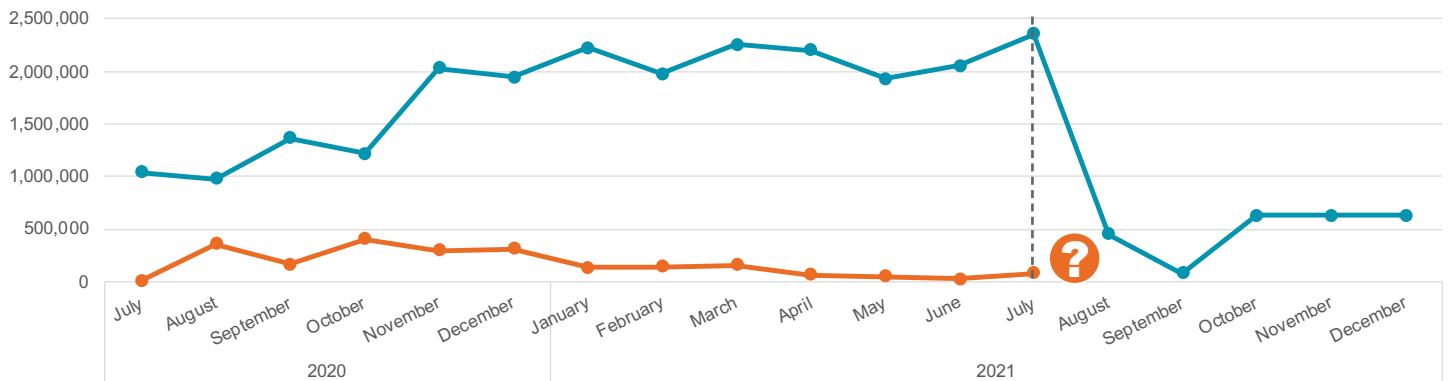
TREND ANALYSIS BY FUNDING SOURCE

FOOD ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES

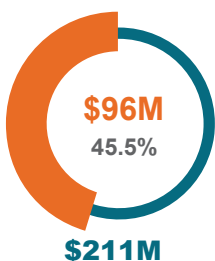


BREAD AND BAKERIES BENEFICIARIES

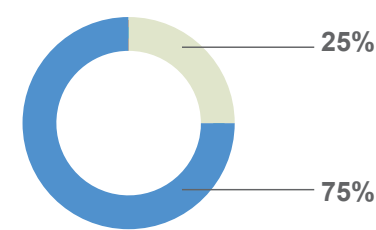

Since UN Security Council Resolution 2533 was renewed in July 2020, Food Security Livelihoods (FSL) Cluster partners **delivered food assistance to 1.8M people in need (on monthly average)** in Northwest Syria.

In May 2021, through the Cross-Border program, FSL partners achieved the following results in Northwest Syria:

- **2.1M beneficiaries** received food assistance (through in-kind, cash or voucher for food)
- **1.9M beneficiaries** reached with bread or flour distribution
- **989.5K beneficiaries** were reached by ready to eat rations, cooked meals, and one-off emergency food baskets,
- **681.5K beneficiaries** were assisted through mixed food items.



FSL Cluster partners reached **934K beneficiaries through agriculture and livelihoods programs** implemented by partners from July 2020 to May 2021.
